Elisabeth Schemla is an award-winning journalist and author. Her book, *Unbowed: An Algerian Woman Confronts Islamic Fundamentalism*, on the Algerian feminist Khalida Messaoudi, has been translated in 10 languages. Her latest book, *Ton Rêve est Mon Cauchemar: les six mois qui ont tué la paix*, deals with the breakdown of the peace process in Israel.

Schemla is the founding editor and chairwoman of *www.Proche-Orient.info* , an Internet news source for Middle-East coverage. She is a former executive co-editor of *L'Express*, France's leading newsmagazine, and she was editor-in-chief for 16 years at the liberal news magazine *Le Nouvel Observateur*.
