Franck Biancheri is Director of Studies and Strategy for the think-tank *Europe 2020*. He is also Director of *Newropeans* Magazine and President of the Newropeans Network, one of the most active European citizens networks, with more than 30,000 members European-wide. He is the president of the TIESWeb Transatlantic Network, which was launched jointly by the European Commission and the US government in 1997 with the mission of strengthening the transatlantic partnership by promoting dialogue between individuals on a people-to-people level. Mr. Biancheri works as a consultant to EU institutions, especially the European Court and Commission, as well as to European national governments. He holds a Master’s degree in Political Science from the Institut d’Etudes Politiques in Paris (Sciences-Po) and is the author of two books: *Vision Europe 2020* about future EU political trends and *GlobalEurope 2020* about future EU foreign policy.
